Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. Now there devout jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound, they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language.

Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice, and proclaimed to them: "You who are Jews, indeed all of you staying in Jerusalem. Let this be known to you, and listen to my words.
